With the Sønderborg Motorway you can quickly reach Motorway E45, which takes you to the rest of Denmark and Germany.



VidensBy Sønderborg

Care guarantee

Sønderborg Municipality has a care guarantee. The municipality's daycare facilities are split into daycare centres (dagpleje), day nurseries (vuggestuer), and kindergartens (børnehaver). Both Danish and German daycare facilities are available, so your child can grow up to be bilingual. We also have an international kindergarten, four 'børneuniverser' (a daycare facility, primary school, and lower secondary school at one site), and a special educational needs facility. Schools in the area

Sønderborg Municipality has many primary and lower secondary schools, where one is a special needs school and four are children's education hubs (børneuniverser), which have close cooperation with the kindergartens, schools, and before- and after-school care centres (SFOs/ klubber). Sønderborg Municipality also has a number of private and independent schools, including German schools and one international school.

At the municipal schools non-Danish speaking children are taught at the reception classes (modtagerklasser). ulkebol.aula.dk

SFOs are available for children in grades 0-2, as are children's clubs (klubber) for those in grades 3-6.

An overview of the municipality's schools can be found at sonderborg.dk/schools. If your child is to attend a private school, you should contact the school directly.



Did you know that...



Music and theatre

The Alsion Concert Hall

The Alsion Concert Hall is famous for its unique acoustics and the hall hosts everything from large international household names to small local choirs, conferences, and stand-up. Alsion is also home to Southern Jutland's Symphony Orchestra (Sønderjyllands Symfoniorkester) – a regional orchestra with 65 permanent musicians. Kunstværket



History and museums

Sønderborg Castle

Sønderborg Castle (Sønderborg Slot) portrays the history of the Southern Jutland region from the Middle Ages to present day with special emphasis on language and culture in the Danish-German border region. msj.dk/en/soenderborg-castle

Tilting-at-the-ring

Tilting-at-the-ring (Ringridning) is popular throughout the municipality, and in the summer several tilting-at-the-ring events are held both on horseback and on bikes. The biggest tilting-at-the-ring festival in Scandinavia is held in Sønderborg. Join the festival at ringriderfesten.dk (in Danish).



Nord-Als Musikfestival

Every year the Nord-Als Music Festival attracts thousands of people around Nordborg Castle, when the entire area is transformed into a festival. Experience the atmosphere, the dancing and the live bands – performed by Danish and local artists. Read more at musikfestival.dk (in Danish).

Woodsculpture

Nature

The Sønderborg area offers a variety of nature experiences. With its 250 kilometres of coastline, many beautiful forests, biking, walking, running, and horse-riding routes, there is something for everyone.



By land...

Nature trails in the Sønderborg area

You will find multiple beautiful forests in the Sønderborg area, where you and your family can go for a walk, ride your bike or try horseback riding, e.g. Gråsten Forests, Nørreskoven in North Alsén and Sønderskoven in Sønderborg. Experience Denmark's longest pier in North Alsén (sonderborg.dk/en/leisure/attractions) or the Gendarme Path, which is one of Denmark's most beautiful coastal hiking trails. The path is 84 km long and runs along the Danish-German border. Read more at gendarmsti.dk/en

Find more hiking trails and biking, riding and running routes at visitsonderborg.com. Gather inspiration from 'Friluftskortet', a map of the outdoors which is available at your local tourist office.
